### Where do I start?

Go straight to the folder ‘\_Edit These’. Then add your content as follows :



### If you're making a Movie Trailer

Edit your **main text** using the compositions contained in the folder :

\_Edit These / Trailer / Text Spots

If you have some, add your **voice-over** to these compositions.

Edit your **main title screen** using the composition :

\_Edit These / Main Title Text

If you have some, add your **voice-over** to this composition.

Edit your **critics' quotes** using the compositions contained in the folder :

\_Edit These / Trailer / Critics Quotes

If you have some, add your **voice-over** to these compositions.

Edit the **additional slides** (MPAA Notice, Production Company, Coming Soon, End Credit Block) using the compositions contained in the folder :

\_Edit These / Trailer / Additional Slides

Add your **movie clips** into the compositions contained in the folder :

\_Edit These / Trailer / Movie Clips

There's a handy folder here to import your source footage.



### If you're making a Title Sequence

Edit your **main text** using the compositions contained in the folder :

\_Edit These / Title Sequence / Text Spots

Edit your **main title screen** using the composition :

\_Edit These / Main Title Text

### Rendering

To render simply find the appropriate composition :

\_Render These / **Drama Trailer**, or

\_Render These / **Drama Title Sequence**

Place it into your render queue and choose your desired output specifications.
