02 // Editing Text

In the Project panel open the folder **01. Edit Comps**

In here are all the editable image and text compositions.

As well as editable **Intro Text** and **Logo** compositions, each **Section** has its own folder of editable text elements. Look for the red, unlocked layers within these compositions to edit the text.

03 // Adding Media

In the Project panel open the folder **01. Edit Comps**

In here are all the editable image and text compositions.

As well as editable **Background** and **Logo** compositions, each **Section** has its own folder of editable image placeholders.

When placing images into **Title Image** placeholders you simply need to fill the hexagonal windows.

In contrast, when placing media into **image compositions other than Title Images**, the red masked areas denote areas of the frame which will be covered, or partly obscured in the final sequence. You should still attempt to cover the entire composition frame when placing images, but keeping the focal point of your image within the unobscured ‘window’.

04 // Changing Colors

In the Project panel open the composition **02. Final Comp / Final Comp**

Change the **Effect colors** on the **top** layer (“CHANGE GREEN COLOR HERE”) to affect colored shapes throughout the entire sequence.

Please note that **this will not alter text colors** as these should be adjusted manually.

05 // Rendering

From the Project panel place the composition **02. Final Comp / Final Comp** into the Render Queue and adjust the Render Settings to your required size and compression.

Hit render !
