// Installing MOGRTs

Installing the MOGRT file

1. Extract the Zip file to reveal the **.mogrt** file.
2. Open Premiere Pro and go to
Graphics > Install Motion Graphics Template
3. Locate the **.mogrt** file.

That's it!

The Motion Graphics Template will appear as a thumbnail image in the **Essential Graphics** panel.

Adding a Motion Graphics clip

Simply drag the template (thumbnail), from the Essential Graphics panel, onto your Sequence timeline to create a clip.

Select the newly created clip on your timeline to bring up the **Edit** controls.

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// Editing MOGRTs

In the **Edit panel** utilize any text, transform and color adjustment controls to customize your graphic.

Once you've finished editing your graphic you can then **drag another instance** of the template, if required, onto your timeline, to bring up a fresh Edit panel, and use different text and settings.

Alternatively, you can Alt/Option-drag the clip to **duplicate the graphic** along the sequence timeline, retaining the settings you've already adjusted.

Repeat multiple times, as necessary.

Please note, the Edit panel shows the **selected** graphic only and is **not related to the playhead position**.

Font Issues

Templates created prior to Premiere Pro 2019, and ones which allow text justification, may not contain the option to use custom fonts.

In these cases, when you **first install** the MOGRT, Premiere Pro will warn you of **required Typekit fonts**.

Please pay attention to any **dialogue boxes** which appear when importing your MOGRT.
